Masaki Yada (Japan, b. 1979) studied at Central St Martins and Chelsea College of Art and Design, graduating in 2008. Yada's practice to date extends across a range of media including painting, photography and drawing often drawing on imagery from the media to comment on broader social and political concerns.

More recently his work has been more introspective, interrogating his interior psychology through dreams, fetishism, childhood memories and an exploration of ideas related to Freud's notion of the 'uncanny' in order to articulate a sense of self, creating compelling dark images.
