**BRUCE MCLEAN** is one of the major figures of contemporary British Art. He studied at Glasgow School of Art and at St. Martin's in London, later teaching at the Slade School of Art. His early reputation arose from his activities as a sculptor involved in performance art and he has obtained international recognition for his paintings and prints, work with film, theatre and books. With this comically titled work, McLean has coalesced these concerns into an image that freezes the artist as a shadowy presence on the border of the frame, perhaps teetering on the edge of sense and madness.
