Painting with raw brushstrokes and in an often spontaneous and overtly naïve style, ROSE WYLIE produces large scale canvases and drawings that feature forms derived from sources as varied as Egyptian painting and sports and film stars. The collage *Night Circus*, presented here is emblematic of Wylie's practice, combining as it does, a simplicity and innocence that under closer inspection, reveals a complex wealth of imagery and style. Wylie received the Paul Hamlyn Award for Visual Arts in 2011.
