Itinerary

Saturday 18 October (Frieze Art Fair & The House of St Barnabas):

Address: Frieze Art Fair, Regent's Park (nearest tube – Regent's Park)

Meeting point – in The Sculpture Park at Frieze Art Fair at 11.20 (a more specific meeting point will be provided nearer the time)

- **11.30** – Welcome & introduction to Frieze Art Fair 2014 with recommendations by **Mark Doyle**
- **12.00 – 16.00** – Guests are free to explore the Fair and also visit Frieze Masters. Please note we will also be arranging short introductions to select galleries throughout this period which you are free to join us for. A schedule and times will be provided on the day

Address: The House of St Barnabus, 1 Greek Street W1D 4NQ (nearest tube – Tottenham Court Rd)

Meeting point – outside the main entrance to The House of St Barnabas at 16.45

- **17.00 – 18.00** – Visit to The House of St Barnabas in Soho to see a site-specific painting installation by **Lothar Götz**. Both Lothar and his gallerist **Domo Baal** will meet us and provide an introduction to the installation. Guests are welcome to stay for early evening drinks at The House of St Barnabas

Sunday 19 October (Studio Visits & Vitrine):

Address: Acme Studios (Matchmakers Wharf), Homerton Road E9 5GP (overground – Hackney Wick or Homerton)

Meeting point – in the courtyard at Acme Studios at 9.45

- **10.00 – 12.00** – Studio visits with **Tom Hackney** and **Hannah Maybank**.

Address: Vitrine (Bermondsey Street), 183-185 Bermondsey Street SE1 3UW (nearest tube – London Bridge)

Meeting point – outside the entrance to Vitrine Gallery at 12.50

- **13.00 – 14.00** – Visit to Vitrine Gallery for an introduction to the current show (*Jonathan Baldock: Notes from the Orifice*) by director **Alys Williams**. Lunch and drinks will also be provided

- **14.00 onwards** – Guests are free to visit some of the major shows on in London during this time. For example, White Cube Bermondsey (showing *Tracey Emin*) and Tate Modern (showing *Malevich*) are very close to Vitrine, but further recommendations will be provided

Important information

- There will be a charge (£20 MEMBERS/£30 NON-MEMBERS) to cover the costs of lunch and organising the trip. This is payable in advance and non-refundable. Payment can be made by contacting **Phil** at the Contemporary Art Society on 020 7017 8415
- The above fee does not include entry to Frieze Art Fair on the Saturday and tickets will need to be purchased by guests. It is recommended this is done in advance as the queues can be long. Further details can be found by visiting <http://friezelondon.com/visitors/tickets/>
